**II. EXECUTIVE COORDINATOR REPORT**

**Kathleen Casey, substituting for Dr. Susan Stone, reminded the Committee about the Frank M. Adams Award Ceremony at Fort Worth Renaissance Hotel at 8:30 AM on June 24<sup>th</sup> and encouraged all to attend.**

**She shared the National Community Indicators Consortium Newsletter Article, which highlighted the MMHTFMC.**

**Kathleen also distributed the “Real Stories” Submission from the MMHTFMC to the National Community Indicators Consortium (CIC) in response to a request for “real stories” about efforts to implement community indicators, and how to translate those into meaningful performance measures. The Monitoring Committee will give an invited presentation on at the International Conference in October in Seattle.**

**She further distributed the one page summary of the ATC Suicide data Initiative. HB 1067 passed and signed by the Governor in direct response to efforts here in Travis County between the MMHTFMC and the Suicide Prevention Coalition. Dr. Stone will distribute the summary at the Texas Council Conference to document this good work. A Memorandum of Understanding between City of Austin HHS and ATCMHMR is in the works. Susan and Marcia Toprac are writing a journal article about this successful collaborative effort.**

**Kathleen announced that there is continued work in the area of Permanent Supported Housing. No new updates on financial modeling, but Dr. Stone will chair a work group around “Best Practices” for Permanent Supported Housing for the Criminal Justice Re-Entry population.**

**Susan is in discussion with others about convening a forum to discuss “frequent users of systems” as part of our overall recommendation about criminal justice system planning. More news will be provided at the next meeting.**
